<p>End of EYFS ELG:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function. • Share their creations, explaining the process they have used. 		
<p>End of KS1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use materials creatively to design and make products • Use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experience and imagination • Develop art technique for example: colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space • Know about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers. Know some of the differences and similarities in their work and make links in their own work.
