



Art at Condover CE Primary School

Intent:

At Condover CE Primary we aim to inspire all children to reach their full academic potential. We aim to provide a wide range of experiences, look at artists from around the world and using a range of different media. We intend to forge links between art and the rest of the curriculum the children will be studying to help make connections between Art and the world around them. Implementation:

Teachers follow the medium term plans, create short term plans tailored to the needs of classes and groups and constantly assess and adapt their teaching and activities to ensure all pupils make progress.

Teaching will include three elements: generating and evaluating ideas; making; and knowledge and understanding. Specific vocabulary should be used to enable pupils to communicate and present their findings effectively using accurate and concise language.

All of our pupils will be confident, creative artists who can use a range of methods and strategies in a wide range of contexts. They will have exposure to opportunities and experiences to deepen their exposure to, and understanding of cultural capital.

Throughout a pupil's journey through Condover CE Primary school, each and every child will make progress. Pupils will also be able to offer opinions about the work of others, both peers and professional artists.
