## National Curriculum

As Writers, following the Talk for Writing approach, we will write an adventure story using the model text 'Adventure at Sandy Cove'. Our focus will be action.

As Readers, we will develop our retrieval, vocabulary and inference skills by reading a range of extracts from fiction and non-fiction texts.

As Mathematicians, we will develop our understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages. We will then look to understand ratios and angles of a shape.

As Scientists, we will be learning about unbalanced forces. We will be investigating gravity, friction, air and water resistance and their effects.

As Geographers, we will be looking to answer the question 'Would you like to live in the desert?'. We will learn the physical features of a desert and look to understand how people live in one.

As Artists, we will investigate how artists explore their identity within their art. We will look at how artists use various aspects of their identity, creating imagery which explores many different aspects within one image by using layers.

In P.E., we will have Shrewsbury Town coaches teaching us this term - handball and dance. PE will be on a Monday and Friday.

In Computing, we will learn how to use spreadsheets. We will organise data into columns and rows to create our own data set.
