
Estuary Class

<p><i>Mains Advantage</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> provides high power for larger appliances cheaper to use ✓ 	<p><i>Battery advantage</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> allows an appliance to move anywhere ✓ can use where there are no electrical sockets ✓
<p><i>Mains Disadvantage</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> can be dangerous ✓ different electrical sockets in different countries ✓ can only be used with access to an electrical socket ✓ only works for appliances that stay in one place ✓ 	<p><i>Battery Disadvantage</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> can be dangerous ✓ will run out and need replacing ✓ can harm the environment so must not go to landfill ✓ makes an appliance heavier ✓
