Polite Reminder

Our sports day took place this week and it was a wonderful afternoon but sadly we had complaints from residents about the parking to deal with the following day. The parking is an issue, and we are working closely with the Parish Council to try and resolve this, but we kindly ask that parents park with consideration for our residents and do not block driveways.

Unfortunately, we have also had contact from Minsterley Motors to say they have recorded 3 near misses in the last six weeks as people are parking in one long stretch outside the school and pre-school and it is causing them to drive on the other side of the road around the blind bend. Again, this is a safety issue, and parents need to park leaving space with cars and buses to pull in if there is oncoming traffic.

Sunny weather



As the sun is starting to make an appearance and the weather is warming up, please could you ensure your child comes to school with a water bottle and a sun hat – both clearly labelled with their full name.

It's also a good time to check that all school uniform is clearly labelled with their full name as it is this time of year that we get a handful of jumpers/cardigans left on the field at the end of playtime.

Ideally sun cream will need to be applied in the morning but if you feel your child will need to re-apply suncream during the day then please ensure it is clearly labelled with your child's full name and left in school. We have will then make sure that:

1. Suncream for each class is kept in a class box.
2. The box will be taken out at breaktime and put in a shady location.
3. Children will be able to re-apply suncream at break and lunchtime if they need to, overseen by staff on duty.





May Half Term Football Camps




