Reminder: Procedures for a minor injury in school

We have sent out the procedures for a minor injury in previous newsletters but would just like to ensure that all parents are aware how minor injuries will be dealt with in school and communicated to parents.

In the event of an accident in school, depending on the type of injury, a first aider will initially examine and treat the injury and inform the class teacher.

Depending on the type of injury a form will be completed.

A bumped head form will always be sent to parents via email so they can monitor for any signs of concussion. If necessary, we will call home to ask parents to come and assess a head injury.

Cuts and grazes will be cleaned but it is likely that the area will need more thorough cleaning when the child gets home.

For any other type of injury an incident form will be completed for school records, this will not be sent home but the class teacher will notify parents at the end of the day.

If it is a serious injury or we have any concerns, we will always call parents straight away.

Sunny weather



As the sun is starting to make an appearance and the weather is warming up, please could you ensure your child comes to school with a water bottle and a sun hat – both clearly labelled with their full name.

It's also a good time to check that all school uniform is clearly labelled with their full name as it is this time of year that we get a handful of jumpers/cardigans left on the field at the end of playtime.

Ideally sun cream will need to be applied in the morning but if you feel your child will need to re-apply suncream during the day then please ensure it is clearly labelled with your child's full name and left in school. We have will then make sure that:

1. Suncream for each class is kept in a class box.
2. The box will be taken out at breaktime and put in a shady location.
3. Children will be able to re-apply suncream at break and lunchtime if they need to, overseen by staff on duty.

Bookings need to be made in advance as the system does not accept bookings on the same day.






