Attendance Review

This week we have had the Educational Welfare Officer in for an attendance review. The aim for attendance is 95% for pupils and for whole school attendance.

The review was positive with a high percentage of children achieving the 95% and above for overall attendance. If your child has scored under 90% for their overall attendance, then letters are issued with the aim of bringing this to your attention and working together to improve this in the final term.

We have sent information out in previous newsletters but just a reminder that if your child is late then this is marked as L, if your child arrives after 9am and the register is closed this is marked as U which is unauthorised. This does not mean that your child is not in school but has arrived after the register has closed and this will affect their overall attendance percentage. Our coding is set by the Local Authority, and we receive this at the start of each new academic year.

If you have received a letter from our Educational Welfare Officer, Lori Caulfield, and have any questions at all you can contact the school office or the Education Access Team directly.

Balance bike-ability training

Sunny weather



As the sun is starting to make an appearance and the weather is warming up, please could you ensure your child comes to school with a water bottle and a sun hat – both clearly labelled with their full name.

It's also a good time to check that all school uniform is clearly labelled with their full name as it is this time of year that we get a handful of jumpers/cardigans left on the field at the end of playtime.

Ideally sun cream will need to be applied in the morning but if you feel your child will need to re-apply suncream during the day then please ensure it is clearly labelled with your child's full name and left in school. We have will then make sure that:

1. Suncream for each class is kept in a class box.
2. The box will be taken out at breaktime and put in a shady location.
3. Children will be able to re-apply suncream at break and lunchtime if they need to, overseen by staff on duty.
