Polite reminders:

Just a polite reminder that at pick-up children should not be using the gym or outdoor equipment. We have a member of staff on gate duty that must lock the gate when everyone has left, so we kindly ask that families leave promptly.

This is also so our Sunset Club children can access the outside areas. This can only be done once everyone has left the school site. If you have a meeting or something to discuss with the class teacher, please come round to the front entrance and sign in.

We have several SchoolMoney accounts that are in arrears, please ensure that these are brought up to date over the Easter break.

Sunny weather

As the sun is starting to make an appearance and the weather is warming up, please could you ensure your child comes to school with a water bottle and a sun hat – both clearly labelled with their full name.

It's also a good time to check that all school uniform is clearly labelled with their full name as it is this time of year that we get a handful of jumpers/cardigans left on the field at the end of playtime.

Ideally sun cream will need to be applied in the morning but if you feel your child will need to re-apply suncream during the day then please ensure it is clearly labelled with your child's full name and left in school. We have will then make sure that:

1. Suncream for each class is kept in a class box.
2. The box will be taken out at breaktime and put in a shady location.
3. Children will be able to re-apply suncream at break and lunchtime if they need to, overseen by staff on duty.


