National Curriculum

As Writers, we will be exploring the features of a spine poem, using this structure we will create our own. Following the Talk for Writing approach, we will write a journey tale, using the model text 'Nail Soup'.

As Readers, we will develop our retrieval, vocabulary and inference skills by reading a range of extracts from books.

As Mathematicians, we will develop our fluency, completing formal written calculations. These skills will be used to help with reasoning and problem solving. We will also be learning about multiplication, division and fractions.

As Scientists, we will be investigating different forces including friction and the uses of it. We will also investigate non-contact forces using magnets.

As Geographers, we will learn where is the Amazon Rainforest is and what it is like. We will compare the rainforest with our local woodlands.

As Designers, we will be creating a functioning torch with a switch according to a given brief.

As Musicians, we will be learning about Samba, Carnival sounds and using instruments to play a pulse.

In P.E., we will have Shrewsbury Town coaches teaching us this term - handball and dance.

In Computing, we will be learning to use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation. Next, we will apply those skills to create a story-based animation.
