Early Years Foundation Stage Framework

As Writers, we will be continuing to practice forming our lower-case letters correctly, and deepening our practice of sentence writing, using capitals letters, finger-spaces and full stops, and including some our tricky words.

As Readers, we will be starting on phase 3 of our Little Wandle phonics scheme focusing further on diagraphs, further embedding our phonetic understanding. We will continue to read in groups three times a week, and share our books at home each weekend.

As Mathematicians, we will be striding further into numerical patterns, shape, space, measures, ordinality and cardinality. We will be counting up to 15, accurately ordering numbers, embedding the concept of one more and one less.

As Scientists, we will be exploring the universe beyond our world, including planets, stars and the Sun, and discovering simple ideas about gravity and why the Sun is so important for life on Earth.

As Geographers, we will be learning about different environments around the world, recognising similarities and differences between where we live and other countries, and beginning to draw information from simple maps.

As Artists, we will be exploring colour and texture, developing our creativity by experimenting with materials, patterns and techniques inspired by our learning.

As Musicians, we will be creating simple actions to familiar songs, learning to find and maintain a steady beat, developing our awareness of tempo and pitch, and discovering how to express ourselves through movement and performance.

In PE, we will be exploring creating shapes, balances, and jumps, showing how to use space safely, and performing basic skills on both floor and apparatus. We will be creating, remembering, and repeating short sequences.

In PSHE, we will be focusing on how to be sensitive towards others, celebrating what makes each person unique, and knowing the importance of cooperation, and showing care and kindness to others.
