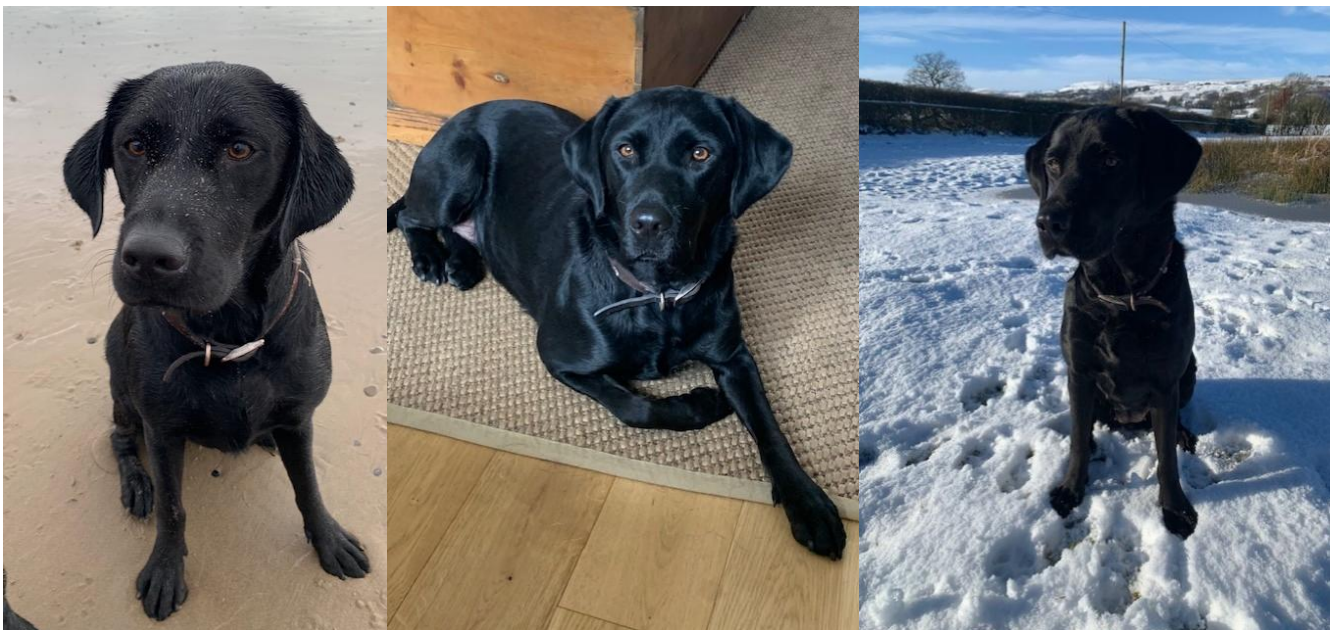
We are finalising our events calendar and will have this ready for the newsletter next week. Keep an eye out for what exciting things we have in store!

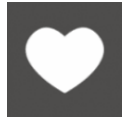

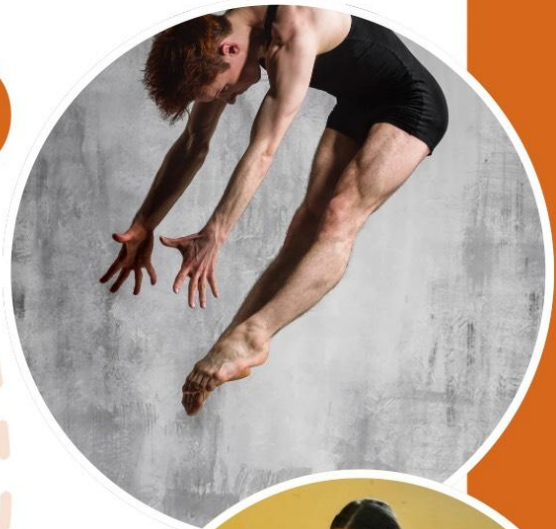
