An email was sent out earlier this week with the following details:

As rehearsals continue for this year's performance of 'Straw and Order' please find below an update on all that you need to know:

Booking is via the google form (link below) and tickets will be on a first come, first serve basis. There will be a limit of 2 tickets per child/ren so we can ensure that everyone has the opportunity to see their child perform.

The deadline for ticket bookings is **Friday 29th November** and you will receive an email to confirm your booking. This may be brought forward if the maximum capacity is reached before then. Please use the form to specify if you are interested in additional tickets, if these are available you will be contacted separately.

Costumes requirements for the play will be emailed out by teaching staff for each class. If you have not received this or have any questions, please contact the class teacher.

The afternoon performance will be at 2pm, children will be able to leave with parents after this performance, however they will go back to class to change out of costumes first and be dismissed from their external class doors by the class teacher as normal.

The evening performance will take place at 6pm. Children are expected to attend both performances and come to the evening performance in their school uniform. Please bring children to the main gate (front gate) at 5.40pm. Children who are attending Sunset Club can go straight from here.

After dropping off the children parents are invited for mince pies and refreshments, served by the friends in Ocean Classroom, a member of staff will collect you from here to enter the hall when they are ready for you.

At the end of the evening performance children will go back to the classroom and be dismissed by the class teacher from their external class doors as they would be normally.

We will be able to provide you with more specific timings in relation to the duration once the dress rehearsal has been done on Monday 2nd December.

We will be filming our dress rehearsal and providing a private link for parents to watch it as in previous years. Please email the office **no later than Friday 29th November** if you do not wish your child to be in the filmed performance.

If younger siblings come to watch, then please be prepared to remove them from the hall should they start disturbing the performance.

If you take photographs or video the children during the performance, please be aware that under no circumstances should it be shared on social media. Also please consider the view of the people around you and the distraction to children on stage.

Our next open afternoon is on Wednesday 11th December 1.30-2.30pm.





