## National Curriculum

**As Writers,** we will be writing poetry, focusing on riddles and 'I am' poems. We will be starting a new fiction unit focusing on journeys. We will be looking at the model text 'The Papaya that spoke' and writing our own versions of it.

**As Readers,** we will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts to discuss different author's styles of writing and to expand our vocabulary.

**As Mathematicians,** we will be focusing on measuring and comparing length and height in centimetres and metres. We will also be learning about different fractions and how these can be represented.

**As Scientists,** we will be identifying the different stages of animal life cycles and how we can stay healthy through exercise and nutrition. We will also be investigating the plant life cycle and recognising the conditions required for germination and healthy plant growth.

**As Historians,** we will be discussing what the monarchy is and how it has developed and changed since William the Conqueror was king.

**As Artists,** we will be starting a stick transformation project where we will create our own models starting with a simple stick.

**As Musicians,** we will be learning about dynamics, timbre, tempo and motifs.

**In D.T.,** we will be finishing our unit on sewing and will create fabric pouches using simple stitches.

**In P.E.,** we will be focusing on athletics, striking and fielding.

**In R.E.,** we will be exploring the question 'Who is Jewish and How do they live?'
