National Curriculum

As Writers, we will be writing a character flaw tale, focusing on using engaging openings and endings to hook the reader, based on the text *The True Story of the Three Little Pigs*. We will then be exploring a non-fiction text called *The Praying Mantis* and writing our own non-chronological report about an animal.

As Readers, we will develop our retrieval, vocabulary and inference skills by reading a range of extracts from books.

As Mathematicians, we will be developing our understanding of number and place value, while working on our mathematical fluency when solving calculations. We will then be learning about the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. These skills form the foundation for developing our reasoning and problem-solving skills.

As Scientists, we will be exploring movement and nutrition in animals, learning about the roles of muscles and skeletons and how energy from food is used by the body to stay healthy. We will also be making connections to previous learning by investigating how hand span affects grip strength.

As Historians, we will be learning about how children's lives have changed over time.

As Geographers, we will be learning about who lives in Antarctica.

As Artists, we will be exploring how we can use drawings to tell stories to one another.

As Designers, we will be learning about the construction of helmets and shell structures.

As Musicians, we will be learning about percussion using our bodies and tuned instruments.

In P.E., we will have Shrewsbury Town coaches teaching us this term on Tuesdays. We will also be working on developing our fundamental skills, such as balancing, running, hopping and skipping, in P.E. on Wednesdays.

In Computing, we will improve our knowledge and understanding of networks and systems and how computers are connected. We will also be learning about the importance of ownership and copyright when using electronic files.

In R.E., we will be learning about the religion of Hinduism and exploring what Hindus believe God is like. We will also be learning about the Trinity.

In PSHE, we will be learning about *Being Me in My World: Who I Am and How I Fit In*.

In French, we will be learning how to describe portraits.
